As usual an international participation this year with two participants from France, Germany and Poland and one participant from Czech Republic, Canada and Ukraine.

Thanks to the software made by Marek SP7DQR all the SWL logs have been checked versus the Ham logs. A lot of Ham logs were (as usual !) in a Cabrillo format not correct and these logs with few exceptions were not cross-checked. This is the reason of the low percentage of QSO/HRD correct (see % in the above tables) of several SWL logs.

The best performance has been made by Richard DL/OK2-31097 an old timer in this Contest. Good performances have also been made by Dusan OK2-9329 in the 12-H Mixed category, Jozef SP4-208 in the 24-H CW category and Allen VO1-001-SWL in the 12-H SSB category. All the participants will receive an Award.

I remember that the IOTA references heard and confirmed in this Contest can be submitted without QSL for the IOTA awards. It is sufficient to submit to me the list with the island name added. The complete procedure is at <http://www.radioascolto.org/swl>.
