Contest Manager's Comments

Participation a little increased this year with two extra-Europe entrants.

Thanks to the software made by Marek SP7DQR all the SWL logs have been checked versus the ham logs. The difference in the score has been in general large except for two logs where the check has been more accurate by checking the corresponding ham log. In many cases the ham log was not in the correct Cabrillo format. By correcting the ham logs and checking again via software the logs the score of these two SWLs increased and so the percentage of QSO/HRD correct (see % in the tables). For the other participants this percentage is low also for the above reason.

The best performance has been made by Rafal SP7-003-24. Good performances have also been made by Peter HA0DW and Richard DL/OK2-31097 an old timer in this Contest. All the participants will receive an Award.
