## Contest Manager's Comments

Thanks to the software made by Marek SP7DQR all the SWL logs have been cross-checked with the ham logs. The preliminary results showed that two SWLs were close in the score and their logs have been more accurately checked together with the corresponding ham logs. As usual many times the ham log was wrong and the swl log was correct. In particular I found several IOTA expeditions with more than 1000 QSO and without the IOTA number in their log. And all the QSO of these expeditions were preliminary marked with "report error" with no points in the corresponding swl log before the correction. The other swl logs have not been checked this way and probably the difference between "Claimed QSO" and "Actual QSO" in the above tables should be lower and the percentage of correct QSO/HRD higher.

The best performance has been made again by Rafal SP7-003-24. Good performances have also been made by Richard DL/OK2-31097 and Patrick F-59706, both old timers in this Contest. The first three participants in each category will receive an Award.

I remember that the IOTA references heard and confirmed in this Contest can be submitted without QSL for the IOTA awards. Just send me the list with the island name added. The complete procedure is at <http://www.radioascolto.org/swl>.
